Outline of Facility Construction

Year	Description
1875	Church Nave and Sanctuary The main church originally consisted of a nave (where the congregation sits), two transepts (wings) with the northern one being the original entrance onto West Baker street, and the sanctuary (where the altar is located).
1926	Parish Hall This building was about the same size as the nave and was a general purpose meeting room.
1943	Walls around the church yard The exact date of the walls is a bit confused. One account records them being built 1942-1943 and another account places them with the narthex in 1945-1947.
1947	Narthex This extension provided for a separate entrance into the nave from the west side after the north transept was closed off for a new organ.
1947	Kitchen Addition
1960	Office Building This building provided space for the rector's office, a conference room, and classrooms in the basement.
1998	Parish Hall and Facility Expansion
2002	Walkways / Patios / Ramp / Stairs Provisions were made so that those with disabilities could more easily enter our facilities. These changes included the addition of a ramp to the narthex as well as regrading the entrances to the parish hall and offices.
